Our Electronic Library is divided into four sections; Surnames, Publications, Newsletters and Research.

The Surname section contains ancestral reports, starting with the earliest known member of that surname and continues to present day descendants. Many of these surnames have cross-pollinated into other family trees so concentrating on just one or two surnames may leave out important clues to your family research.

Our Publications section is a collection of books and other material that many have found helpful in building their family history. These publications are in the “Public Domain” meaning they can be downloaded and reprinted without copywrite concerns.

Newsletters are, as its name implies, copies of our monthly newsletter.

The Research Section is a list of on-going research projects which have been opened to the public for comment and participation.
